

Nagoya Institute of Technology Academic Data Policy

Adopted March 22, 2023

(Purpose)

1. Pursuant to the Nagoya Institute of Technology Charter, Nagoya Institute of Technology (hereinafter "NITech") establishes as its fundamental mission to serve as a continuous source of new industry and culture, to create innovative academic and technological advances, to cultivate capable human resources, and to contribute to the peace and wellbeing of future society.

In furtherance of this mission, NITech shall accumulate intellectual achievements generated through its activities and disseminate them to society, thereby advancing research and education while fulfilling its social obligations.

This policy hereby establishes the fundamental principles governing the management, publication, and utilization of academic data at NITech.

(Definition of Academic Data)

2. For the purposes of this policy, academic data shall refer to any data collected or generated through research and educational activities at NITech.

(Management of Academic Data, etc.)

3. The methods for managing, publishing, and utilizing academic data may be determined by the parties responsible for its collection or generation, provided such methods comply with applicable laws, NITech regulations and other equivalent standards and do not infringe upon the rights and legal interests of any third parties.

(Obligations of NITech Members)

4. Members of NITech engaged in research or educational activities (hereinafter "NITech Members") shall appropriately manage academic data within the scope set forth in the preceding paragraph, make such data publicly available to the maximum extent possible, and facilitate its utilization.

(Obligations of NITech)

5. NITech shall establish and maintain an environment that supports the management, publication, and utilization of academic data.
